

Brassmasters' 2024 CMP Sanctioned 1800 & EIC Precision Pistol Matches

Location: White Horse Firearms and Outdoor Education Center, Brassmasters Pistol Range 127 White Horse Lane, Philippi, WV 26416; County Route 20/3, Crouse Road

Dates & Time: April 13th, June 1st, August 3rd, October 5th All matches will begin firing promptly at 10:00am, LPT

Eligibility: Open to all eligible participants. You do not have to be a member of a Civilian Marksmanship Program Affiliated Club (CMP) to participate. New shooters/beginners are encouraged to participate and will be allowed to use a two-handed grip

Entry Fee: 1800 Matches \$25.00 for both guns or \$15.00 for one gun. EIC Match Entry Fee is \$20-- \$15 of each entry fee to CMP

Classification: Current CMP Outdoor Precision Pistol Classification will be used. Competitors may compete using their current NRA Precision Pistol Outdoor Classification if their NRA Classification is higher than their current CMP Classification, but not lower than their CMP Classification. Unclassified shooters will compete in the Master Class. Current CMP Rules will govern all matches

Award Schedule: Awards for the 1800 will be cash payments, based on the number of competitors. CMP Awards (leg points & medals) for the EIC Matches will be provided by the CMP. The award schedule is based on a minimum of six (6) entries per class. If less than six (6) entries in a class, that class may be combined with the next higher class except the Master Class, at the discretion of the Match Director

Rules: Current CMP Rules apply. Challenge fee \$1.00 per challenge, the Scoring Officer's decision is final, Rule 3.10.5. Challenge fee will be returned if challenge is upheld

Course of Fire: This will be a two (2) gun match, a 22 Caliber Matches 1,2,3,4 & 5=900 aggregate; Center Fire Matches 6,7,8,9 & 10=900 aggregate. Competitors may enter one or both matches. Targets: 50yard slow fire, B-6; 25yard Timed & Rapid Fire B-8. Course of fire of the Service Pistol & .22 Rimfire EIC Matches is The National Match Course: 1 slow fire target, 1 Timed Fire Target and 1 Rapid Fire Targets, 30 rounds. The Service Revolver Match will be the President's Match, consisting of 2 slow fire targets, one timed fire target & one rapid fire target for a total of 40 rounds

General: Safety Flags/Empty chamber indicators, eye and hearing protection are mandatory. The range is equipped with electronically-timed pneumatic turning targets and covered firing points. Triggers may be weighed and ammunition checked for the EIC Matches to verify compliance with CMP rules

Registration: Will be a walk-up registration on the day of the match to range capacity

Refreshments: Refreshments will be available at the range, bring your own lunch
